



# LINCOLNWAY SPECIAL RECREATION ASSOCIATION

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Update 3-18-2020

In an attempt to answer additional questions LWSRA has received, listed below is a timeline and the most recent questions and answers. If you feel that you have come in contact with someone that has tested positive for the Coronavirus please self-isolate as soon as possible and notify your primary care provider if you develop symptoms. Currently, no other staff or participants at LWSRA have reported any symptoms. The Lincolnway Special Recreation Center has closed as of March 16th. The building and buses will be professionally cleaned and sanitized the week of March 27th.

## Timeline

- March 4<sup>th</sup> - 5<sup>th</sup> - Participant may have come in contact with someone at Elim Christian Services in Crestwood. Please note this is not confirmed. <https://patch.com/illinois/alsip-crestwood/elim-christian-services-employee-tests-positive-coronavirus>
- March 6<sup>th</sup>- Participant attended LWSRA program (Shamrock Shuffle, Participant was in the LWSRA facility approximately 20 minutes around 6pm)
- March 8<sup>th</sup>- Participant attended LWSRA program (Wolves Game, not in LWSRA facility)
- March 9<sup>th</sup>- Participant attended LWSRA program (Thunder Bowlers, not in LWSRA facility)
- March 12<sup>th</sup>- Participant showed symptoms. LWSRA was not aware at this time.
- March 13<sup>th</sup>- LWSRA canceled programs and cleaned buses and vehicles (LWSRA did not know individual was infected at this time)
- March 16<sup>th</sup> - LWSRA received notice from parent that participant had tested positive.
- March 16<sup>th</sup> - LWSRA suspended all programs and closed the Lincolnway Special Recreation Center. Staff started to notify all parties.

## A message from the parent of the individual who tested positive:

*"Sorry all these questions! I'm sure I'd be asking too. If it helps you can update that the individual didn't have any symptoms until Thursday 3/12 afternoon. He has had a very mild case as of now. Fever one night- 3/12 and cough which is far & few between, nearly gone now.*

*All my best"*

Q. Was this person on the buses or vans?

A. Yes, buses.

Q. Were all vehicles sanitized after Friday, March 6th and Sunday, March 8th?

A. Yes

Q. Sanitized daily starting what date?

A. March 13th, There were no confirmed cases at LWSRA at that time but we were trying to be proactive.

Q. Are any of your staff experiencing symptoms?

A. No

Q. I was at a restaurant eating lunch on the 9th. Your clients were there. Was the infected individual there and did the infected individual use vehicle prior?

A. No, the individual that tested positive was not at that program. Yes, the individual was on bus the day prior to that program going out.

Q. Why did you decide to move the polling place?

A. We felt it was in the best interest of the community to close our building, not having all the facts.

Q. Why did you cancel board meeting, and will it be rescheduled?

A. We felt it was in the best interest of the community to close. As far as rescheduling no, we will meet at our April posted scheduled.

Q. My Son/daughter was at the dance and Danced with \_\_\_\_\_ participant. Can you tell me if they danced together?

A. No, We cannot release participant information. If you think your child has been directly contacted please self-isolate for 14 days and monitor for symptoms.

Q. I was at the Wolves game. What section did you sit in?

A. Section 116, Row P, Q, R, Seats 1-7

Q. My daughter works at the bowling alley have they been notified?

A. Yes

Q. Have you notified the other agencies that were at the Shamrock Shuffle?

A. Yes

Q. Is the case in Tinley Park?

A. No

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
