LWSRC is my child's drop-off location. What if I'm late picking them up?

For individuals using LWSRA as a drop off point, on days an individual is not registered but LWSRA staff accepts them off the bus, there will be a \$15 fee. An additional \$15 fee will be assessed for every 15 minutes thereafter that the individual is under LWSRA supervision.

How do I sign up?

Monthly registration forms are available online at lwsra.org/afterschool. Submit the form with the days you want your child to attend that month.

How do I pay?

You may select which days you want to attend in advance and you may pay for the entire month or pay one week in advance (by Thursday the week before). A late fee will be assessed if not received by 6:30pm on THURSDAY the week before. This deadline ensures time for us to adequately schedule staff based on the number of attendees. Late registrations must also receive prior approval.

Late Pick-Ups:

Each time a participant is picked up after 6:30pm, a \$15.00 fee will be charged for every 15 minutes or portion thereof. Payment is due to LWSRA within one week of notification. Attendance at future programs will not be allowed until all outstanding fees are paid. If a participant is picked up late multiple times, suspension of future programs may occur.

Refunds/Credits:

Refunds/credits will not be given due to vacations or weather related cancellations for days you have registered for.

How do I set up transportation?

Transportation for your child needs to be set up through your child's school district. Contact your transportation company to change the drop off location to: LWSRC, 1900 Heather Glen Dr., New Lenox, IL 60451. LWSRA does not provide transportation services. IMPORTANT NOTE: Different school districts have different policies on drop off locations and schedule variations. Please contact Melissa Jensen with any questions or for clarification.

Do you provide a snack?

Parents have the option to add-on \$0.50 a day for snack or pack your own.

Registration Deadline:

Late Fee of \$25.00 if registration is not received by 6:30pm on the THURSDAY the week before. The LWSRA office must approve registrations for the upcoming week if received after the deadline.

What forms or paperwork do I need to fill out?

In addition to the monthly After School Care Registration Form, participants must have a valid Annual Information Form (AIF) on file with LWSRA. If individual is subject to seizures, please complete a seizure form. Permission to dispense medication forms are also available for those needing staff to dispense medication during the program.
